

Hunting



You will hunt over ground belonging to 3 different estates in central Perthshire. Together, these estates comprise over 35,000 acres of scenic countryside offering some of the very best roe stalking in Scotland. The ground you will be covering is mostly arable and deciduous and conifer woodland strips. The walking is generally very easy. You may also shoot from high seats, depending on weather conditions and the disposition of the deer. Our proposal is based on your shooting 2 outings over 2 days with the expectation of shooting 2 bucks in total. Please note that it is customary to tip the estate's stalker £20-30 per buck shot.



In accordance with Scots Law, visiting hunters are required to obtain UK Visitor Permits for the use of imported rifles in Scotland. The process requires River & Green to act as your sponsors in support of the application. The process requires about 4-5 weeks to complete and all associated fees are included in this proposal. For those who do not possess a valid firearms or hunting license, it is required by law that they are accompanied by the owner of the hired-out rifle. All hunters must be in possession of fully comprehensive insurance. You will be asked to produce your certificates of insurance before hunting can commence.
